ADMINISTRATION:

OPERATIONS:

The surveys are one of many newly required things we must do since our population went over 50,000, but the good news is they only have to be done every 5 years, so we will be done with them as of June 30 until July 2007. Wheelchair Lifts: We had hoped that the new Orions would allow us to have wheelchair lifts on all scheduled service except the parking lot shuttle. The delay in the delivery will make this very difficult. On days when we do not have enough lift equipped buses, we will run non-lift buses on Orange route. If a passenger needs a lift to board Orange, call your friendly dispatcher and a minibus will be sent out immediately to pick them up. (Bob)
